CABIN INFORMATION

CHECK IN & CHECK OUT

Check-in starts at 2 PM and check-out is at 10 AM. Need to come early or leave late? We can usually work something out—just a heads-up that there might be a fee.

TOILETS & SHOWERS

Please note that the cabins do not have toilets. However, you can easily access two amenity blocks via the footpath—one to the north and one to the south. Both blocks are equipped with toilets and hot showers. There is a hot outdoor shower located at the back of your cabin for your use. Enjoy the refreshing experience in nature! Eco-friendly soap and towels are provided for your convenience.

For families, there is a family bathroom available in the southern amenity block.

LAUNDRY

Coin-operated machines are available in the southern amenity block. You can obtain change at reception. We also sell laundry powder for \$3. **Washing: \$6 Drying: \$8**

KETTLE & DRINKING WATER

The kettle can be filled using the tap on the verandah. All water at the park is filtered and safe to drink. Bottled drinking water is available for purchase in the minibar, and larger bottles can be bought from the Sandbar, open daily from 12 PM to 8 PM.

WIFI

Complimentary Wi-Fi is available—please ask for a voucher at check-in.

Each voucher is valid for 24 hours. If you're staying multiple nights, feel free to stop by and request additional vouchers as needed.

TOWELS & LINEN

Towels are provided complimentary.

If you need additional towels, a towel hire fee of \$10 applies.

Planning to use the sofa bed?

Linen can be purchased for a \$20 fee.

If you've booked a room with children, sofa bed linen should already be provided.

Blankets are also available—just ask at check-in.

MINIBAR

Our mini bar is stocked with local produce from the Daintree region for your convenience. While it's entirely up to you whether you choose to use it, please fill out the mini bar form and return it to reception at check-out if you do.

Please note that any items taken or damaged from the mini bar will be charged to the credit card provided at check-in.

If you enjoyed any of the local products in the mini bar, we have more available at reception! Feel free to purchase some to take home as gifts or souvenirs.

Tea & Coffee is complimentary.

TELEVISION

Its raining perfect fire up the cabin TV – which are set up for streaming only (no free-to-air channels), so you'll need to log in with your own accounts like Netflix, Channel 7, or other streaming services. The tv's are already connected to the park wifi. Remotes can be found under the tv – please see office if you have any issues

AIRCONDITIONERS

Air conditioner remotes can be found mounted on the wall.

To help us conserve energy, please set the temperature to 24°C when you're not in the room.

OUTDOOR SHOWER

Eco-friendly soap is provided for your use, and we kindly ask that you use it to help protect the environment. Enjoy showering in nature—just a heads-up, since you're outdoors, you might encounter some frogs and bugs!

Please be mindful of others' privacy and avoid walking around the other cabins outdoor showers.

PARKING

Each cabin has one designated parking space, which is signposted. Please only park in the allocated area.

If you have multiple vehicles or guests visiting, additional parking is available outside the boom gate near reception.

LOST PROPERTY

While we're not responsible for any items lost or left behind (as outlined by the Innkeepers Act, Australia), we're always happy to help! If we find anything after your stay, we'll safely hold it at reception for you to collect.

LOST KEY

If you happen to lose your key, a replacement fee of \$30 will apply.

RULES & SAFETY

- For safety reasons, no candles are allowed inside the cabins.
- Smoking is not permitted inside the cabins or any public areas.
- Please be considerate of others—no loud music to help maintain a peaceful environment for all guests.
- Cooking is not allowed inside the cabins; kindly use the designated outdoor cooking areas.
- Pets are not permitted inside the cabins.
- Children must be supervised near the mini bar, as it contains alcoholic beverages.
- **Locking Doors and Windows:** For your safety, always lock the cabin doors and windows when leaving the cabin.
- **Damage to Property:** Please report any damage or issues with the cabin immediately. Guests will be responsible for any damage caused during their stay.
- **Proper Disposal:** Please dispose of trash in the provided bins and recycle where possible. Help us keep the cabins and grounds clean.
- **Respect the Environment:** Please avoid disturbing wildlife or the natural surroundings. Keep noise levels low and use the outdoor areas respectfully.
- **No Unregistered Guests:** For security reasons, only registered guests are allowed to stay in the cabin. Any visitors must check in at reception.

CAPE TRIBULATION TOURS

Ocean Safari

Snorkelling tour out to the Great Barrier Reef. Departs twice daily for a morning tour at 7:30am and an afternoon tour at 11:30am. Bookings can be made at Cape Trib Camping reception.

Treetops Adventure

Zipline tour through the oldest rainforest in the world. Approximately a 2-hour guided tour. Minimum age: 4. Guests aged 4-12 must be accompanied by an adult. Bookings can be made through <https://treetopsadventure.com.au/>.

Cape Tribulation Wilderness Cruises

The only crocodile cruise on our side of the ferry! Departs twice daily at 11:30am and 2pm. Bookings can be made at Cape Trib Camping reception.

Jungle Escapes

Night walks through the rainforest. Family friendly night walk at 6:00pm and regular night walk at 7:30pm. Bookings can be made by calling +61 407 734 702.

Cape Trib Horse Rides

Guided horse riding tour through the rainforest and down onto the beach. No experience necessary. All children between 10 and 14 must be accompanied by an adult. Bookings can be made by calling directly at 1800 111 124 or booking through <https://www.capetribhorserides.com.au/>.

Far North Escapes

Night walks through the rainforest. In busy times, they depart twice nightly at 7pm and 9pm. They also have other tours on offer such as Cooktown, Cape York, and day walks through Cape Tribulation.

Cape Trib Farm

Exotic fruit tasting tour. Try the delicious fruit that is grown right at Cape Trib Farm. Generally available Monday, Wednesday, Friday & Saturday. Bookings can be made through <https://www.capetribfarm.com.au/>.

Daintree Discovery Centre
